### **Expedition Plan**

#### **STEP 1: Choose your adventure.**

- a. This can be as simple as a hike.
- b. Go to your state Department of Natural Resources or Tourism site and explore.

#### **STEP 2: Gather the details:**

- a. Go to the website.
- b. Be sure of accessibility.
- c. Open time, days.
- d. Contact fellow A-team adventurers and confirm interest.

#### **Step 3: Make the plan:**

- a. Confirm the Date and Timeframe for the event.
- b. Decide the Adventure Guide, contact name, number, email.
- c. Decide on transportation – meet on your own or organize a group option.
- d. Determine supplies, gear, rental equipment. Be specific as possible.
- e. Number of adventurers. Be specific. Are Adventure Guides needed, too? (Volunteers)
- f. Cost and details. Bring cash, a check, written out to.... Or sign up online. Include link.

#### **Step 4: Promote:**

- a. Create a flyer, email blast, invitation to the event. Include RSVP and Guide contact information.
- b. Use the A-Team Adventure logo.
- c. Post on social media.
- d. Send to [ateamgrassroots@gmail.com](mailto:ateamgrassroots@gmail.com)

**Step 5: Capture the adventure.**

- a. Designate at least one A-Team Adventurer to take photos.
- b. Be sure all Adventurers sign a release if in pictures, or videos.
- c. Confirm the Adventure Guide will complete the A-Team Adventure Wrap Up and send to [ateamgrassroots@gmail.com](mailto:ateamgrassroots@gmail.com) after the event.
